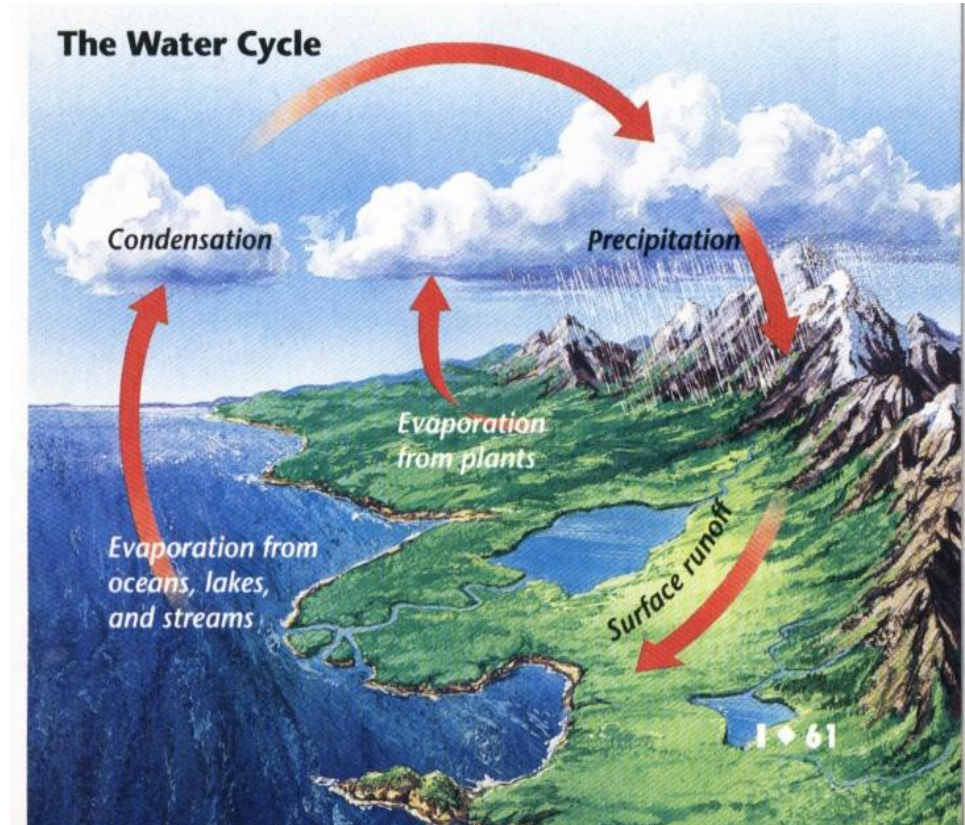
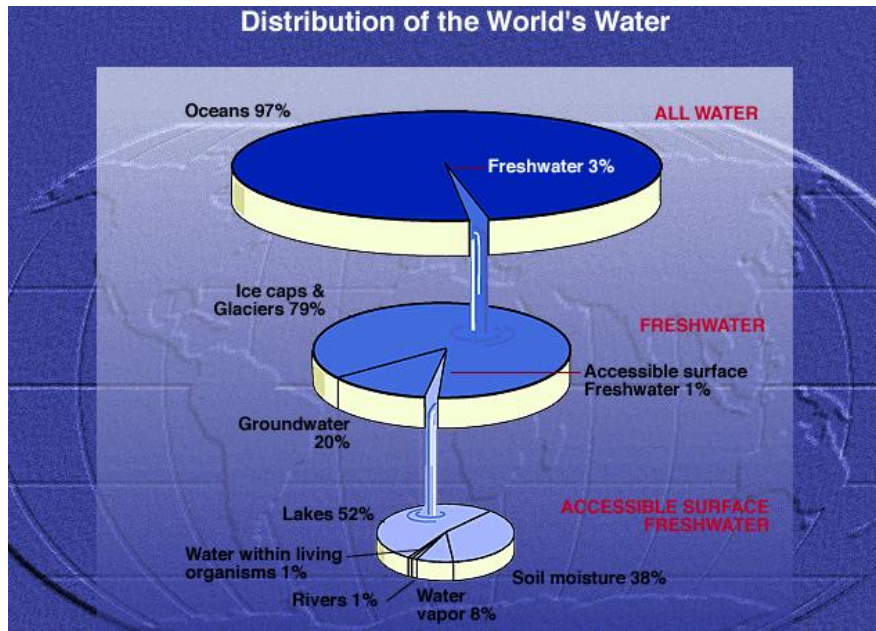


The Water Cycle

The movement of water on Earth.



Precipitation – any form of water that is deposited on Earth. There are four types: rain, snow, sleet, and hail.

Infiltration – the downward movement of water through soil.

Transpiration – the evaporation of water from plants.

Evaporation – the changing of liquid water droplets to water vapor in the atmosphere.

Condensation – the changing of water vapor to liquid water droplets to create clouds.
